PROPERTY TAXES

Are due each year on December 31. The Village office accepts cash, cheque, debit, e-transfer & online payments through BMO, CIBC, ICU, Scotia, Tangerine & Telepay.

DISCOUNT & PENALTY

The Village of Meota has a Property Tax Incentive & Penalty Bylaw that allows for a **5% discount** for prepayments made on current municipal taxes from Jan. 1 until Aug. 31. Taxes that remain unpaid after Dec. 31 a **12% penalty** will be applied to any outstanding balance of taxes January 1st each year.

EMAIL NOTICES

The Village of Meota is now set up to provide tax and assessment notices by email. This option offers a faster, more convenient, and environmentally friendly way to receive your annual tax information.

If you would like to register for emailed notices, please contact the Village Office to complete the required consent form.

TREES ON VILLAGE PROPERTY

May not be removed, pruned or destroyed in any way, without the written consent from the Village of Meota and in turn, no trees are to be planted on Village property without the written consent from the Village of Meota. Please contact the Village office for more information.

BUILDING, RENOVATION & DEMOLITION PERMITS

Thinking about building, renovating or demolishing? Make sure you have a permit! The Village of Meota has an Official Community Plan & Zoning Bylaw in place to manage development and requires that any person looking to make improvements or subdivide their property to make application. Please note that all inspection/permit fees are the responsibility of the applicant and must be paid in full before construction commences. Forms can be obtained from the Village office or Northbound Planning.

DEVELOPMENT PERMIT: Required for any type of new construction over 100sq ft including decks, fences, sheds, garages, signs, any change in use & home-based businesses. Northbound Planning is currently contracted to provide planning services to the residents of Meota and all applications must be approved by them before any work is commenced. Some applications may require Council approval.

BUILDING PERMITS: Required for any new construction including houses, RTM's, commercial & industrial developments, garages, carports, decks, mobile homes, renovations or alterations to existing buildings, basement development and retaining walls. Once the development permit has been approved & permit fees have been paid, the completed building permit is then sent to Construction Code Authority for review the project & provide approval.



FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

For the Village are provided by the Meota & District Volunteer Fire Department. Should you require services from the MDFD, you will be invoiced accordingly, as fire protection is not provided through your tax dollars. Ensure you have made arrangements with your property insurance company for firefighting coverage.

FALSE ALARMS

Residents with alarm systems are reminded that there is a charge should the Fire Department be dispatched to your property due to a false alarm. Make sure to answer your phone from your Security Company or call to let them know it's a false alarm so the Fire Department is not called.
