## BYLAW #2/2012

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Village of Meota in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Village of Meota.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
  - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
  - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
  - 5. Every person who contravenes a bylaw with permits and/or licenses attached shall:
    - a. In the case of an individual not holding an outdoor fire permit as per schedule "A" of Bylaw #4/2012, a bylaw respecting fire prevention, shall be penalized \$500.00.
    - b. In the case of an individual not holding a fireworks display permit or a pyrotechnics permit as per schedule "B" and "C" of Bylaw #4/2012, a bylaw respecting fire prevention, shall be fined \$1000.00.
    - c. In the case of an individual not holding any other permits or licenses required as per the following bylaws:
      - i. Bylaw #1/99, A bylaw respecting Business Licenses
      - ii. Bylaw #10/2012, A bylaw respecting buildings Shall be fined \$250.00.
  - 6. Every person who contravenes bylaw #9/2012, Parking Bylaw shall be fined
    - a. \$20.00 regular parking ticket
    - b. \$75.00 parking in a handicap zone
  - 7. Bylaw #51, a Bylaw to provide enforcement of bylaws in the Village, is hereby repealed
